NOTICE OF PUBLICITY OF A NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN PROPOSAL

Longhorsley Parish Council has prepared a Draft Neighbourhood Development Plan for the Longhorsley Neighbourhood Area. The Plan proposes a number of planning policies which, once adopted, must be used in the determination of planning applications within the Parish.

The Parish Council is required to publicise the Draft Plan and invite comments. Copies of the Plan will be available for public inspection for a period of not less than six weeks commencing on **16th June 2017** and ending at **31st of July 2017**

All representations will be publicly available and will be considered by the Parish Council in producing the final Plan which will then be submitted to Northumberland County Council as local planning authority for Independent Examination.
