4. MATTERS ARISING FROM FLOOR

- 4.1 The path between the line of cottages going out of Greenhead to the B6318 was brought up by a resident. It was claimed that it had been built incorrectly in the first place.
- 4.2 Complaints were made about the position of the lighting as there is nothing on the link road and then clusters of them in Greenhead. Cllr Sharp will look into that.
- 4.3 The wall at The Old Post Office Garden was discussed, Network Rail are still denying responsibility.
- 4.4 The Chair of Governors from the school asked to speak. He informed Councillors that the school has a support plan with Northumberland County Council and are keen to build a relationship back with the community. There will be an open day on June 29th for residents to look around the pre-school and the school. They will be actively encouraging local children to attend the school. The school will be issuing a newsletter to explain their situation. The governors would like to find someone to act on behalf of the community with the school. Cllr Wood suggested that someone from the school should join the village hall committee also. Cllr Graham asked if he could have the figures of the proportions of redundancies that were made and what costs were attributed to Greenhead in an attempt to explain how Greenhead's deficit was accrued.
