39/18	Correspondence received since the last council meeting A list of correspondence is available from the clerk. The Local Transport Plan has been received. It is to be sent around Councillors for their suggestions.		
40/18	Flood Updates A new contact, Colin Hall, from the Environment Agency has been out to look at the woods near Blenkinsopp. He has suggested that they will send a letter to the owner asking them to clear the woods and ditches as they are a flood and/or a fire risk. The Village Hall Committee have been asked if the hall can be used as a rest room in the event of a flood. It was suggested that Blenkinsopp may be able to offer this facility for residents on that side of the A69. Cllr Wood will approach them.		
41/18	Northumberland County Council Local Plan There is an open day in Haltwhistle Library on Saturday 4 th August for residents to find out more about the plan. The consultation finishes on Wednesday 15 th August 2018.		
42/18	Grounds Maintenance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is a section of wall down in the play area. A resident has offered to repair it. • The back fence has had a section taken out. Michael Glenwright has suggested a repair similar to that done in a play area in Haltwhistle for the whole fence. The clerk will photo this and send it around councillors for approval. • There is no more money in the S106 pot but, after a discussion, the council agreed that they would still like to go ahead and purchase the two pieces of equipment. The clerk will inform Kompan and ask if they will remove the old equipment in situ. • More bark is needed in the park and will be co-ordinated with the new equipment • A new bin was discussed and councillors agreed to go to the park after the meeting to assess the one there. <p>Council agreed to order the play equipment from Kompan and more bark at the same time.</p> PROPOSED Cllr J Robson SECONDED Cllr M Wood AGREED
