Planning Applications Approval received for Garden House Farm and West lodge, Rothley.

Correspondence The following was received and circulated. Via mail; Clerks and Council, Great North Air Ambulance, CAN, CPRE, War Memorials trust and Northumberland Estates. Via email; NCC Car parks, NCC Council tax base, NCC Council precept, NCC sport and play.

Any Other Business Councillor Glen Sanderson gave an update, proposed new car parking plans for county, 26M to save next year, try to protect frontline services. NCC having an anti littering campaign. Country parks being upgraded and County Hall refurbished. Pot holes - council trying to carry out more permanent repair, cut out and fill. Some new funding for roads from National government 7.7M. Broadband remains a problem trying to organize another meeting set for 4/12, no details on where is included in plan. Wanting to try a kerbside glass recycle scheme. Arch has been replaced by Advance Northumberland. JF gave a report on Town and parish conference in October, an interesting presentation by Liz Morgan of public Health that was going to produce a directory services available to Northumberland giving public support. Peter Jackson give progress in county in last year, and two new bodies North of Tyne Authority and Borderlands. CAN AGM-funds looking healthy, warm hubs doing well, oilcan continuing, National Village Hall week at end of January.
