<u>Finance</u> We received an acknowledgment of submission from PKF Littlejohn, they will contact if any problems otherwise accounts approved.

<u>Planning Applications</u> We have received acknowledgment of council comments to Byway 18. We have not received any conformation to comments made about hen unit JF to follow up. Plans looked at for Rothley Crag cottage no issues raised.

<u>Correspondence</u> The following was received and circulated. Via mail; Clerks and Council, NCC Hazardous waste, North Northumberland Hospice Care, post office scam mail and Glasdon. Via email; Town and Parish liaison, Community Foundation, NCC refuse collection, A1 improvements, superfast broadband update, NALC e news, cluster minutes and joint burial minuets, WCBF.

Any Other Business Councillor Glen Sanderson sent an update on NCC need to make 30 million budget cuts in next 3 years, hopes to protect front line services. Road side verge cutting finished by end of July and weed spaying gone well. Beginning new 1.2M structural patching of roads programme. Grit and salt arriving for winter bins filled. Broadband remains a problem trying to organize another meeting. Update on Broadband situation, Rothley now in plan, JF to contact JC to see which properties left out. Defibrillator since last meeting JF has spoken to Stephen Carey fund about problems with phone box. Second electrician had been to box, electric cable behind panel unable to use as live, contacted NEDL about this engineer said not a problem as covered. JF also spoke to publican about putting defib on pub. EB going to talk to Dukes agent about this and Stephen Carey fund to see if we can get some progress, DB to speak to pub. JF had been to WWCBF and Cluster meetings minutes circulated. EB had attended meeting at Morpeth about North of Tyne authority and elected mayor. Issues raised Education, rural transport, promise made on 100% broadband connectivity. EB also attended event on core strategy highlighted education not included need good relevant college courses in county, need to use developer's money for improving local services.
