To continue from my last report the school now has a 10 year plan in place and is gaining strength and pupils I continue to have contact with the chair of governors and am assured of the schools continued progress.

The bus shelter now has a new panel and other small improvements about the village have being done by Angela and Mick Yates for which we are really grateful, the clearing of trees and bushes along the entrance road and the A69 by NCC has made it easier to read signs and see oncoming traffic although after the accident on the main junction I feel we should have a fresh attempt at obtaining lighting for it.

Improvements too the war memorial are still being pursued with one suggestion being rejected but we will continue.
