**Parking Restrictions: C16 Beal to Holy Island Causeway:** To tackle problem parking beside the road to the Causeway, County are proposing an experimental ban on all parking on the stretch of road from the bend after the Barn at Beal. The effectiveness of the measure will be monitored. Without formal restrictions in place, enforcement action cannot be taken against motorists parking dangerously.



**Lindisfarne Nature Reserve:** To protect birds in the area, and manage increasing numbers of dog owning visitors, in a trial lasting until 1<sup>st</sup> September, Natural England has introduced a **Dog Zoning Scheme**, which will be marked by temporary signage at recognised access points. In some parts no dogs will be allowed, and in others they will have to be kept on a short lead. The Parish Council was not consulted before the scheme was introduced but a consultation at the end of the trial is promised. If considered successful it may be implemented all year round.



**Fenwick Parking:** Aiming to alleviate the situation of cars parking on the bend on the north side of the B6353, the Parish Council is considering the use for parking of a section of the grass verge on the south side of the B6353 between its junction with the U34 (Detchant road) westwards towards the A1 past the Manor House.

Before any firm proposals are made to Highways for their approval the Parish Council would like to hear from anyone with alternative suggestions.

**Kyloe Woods:** Concern has been expressed at signage suggesting restrictions on access on a gate leading into the woods via the C18. This gate does not lead to a designated footpath. In 2018 County proposed modifications to the Rights of Way Definitive Map which would add and upgrade to the paths in the wood. Any Order requires approval from the Secretary of State in whose hands it currently rests.
