<b>Erection of monuments (within prescribed limits)</b>	<b>180.00</b>

## **NORTH SUNDERLAND PARISH COUNCIL**

### **Erection of a memorial seat**

**Permission must be granted by the Parish Council for erection of a seat. A picture of the proposed seat should be provided with the request.**

**The person(s) requesting the seat must supply three flag stones for a base for the seat. To be responsible for anchorage and for insurance, a copy of which must be shown to the Parish Council.**

**Should the seat fall into disrepair the Parish Council will contact the owner(s) advising of the situation and give a time limit of three months to repair or remove.**

**The Parish Council also has the right to remove a seat should it be unsuitable for repair and the owner(s) have failed to rectify the situation.**
