

Currently nothing the council can do as these we think are owned either by Karbon homes or NCC. If they belong to Karbon will raise a complaint with them.</p> <p>351.2 Grass Cutting and the beck? Have raised this with Karbon homes and awaiting a reply from them, will chase up if nothing happens</p> <p>351.3 Can the council reconsider a defibrillator? 356	<p>Correspondence 356.1 NCC Surface Dressing, details were given regarding dates that this would be taking place and locations on road closures. 356.2 All other correspondence was dealt with on the agenda 356.3 Email received concerning the garages in the estate, this was dealt with in the public questions section.</p>
