70/22	<p>Greenhead Village Hall Pop up Bar - Cllr M Wood clarified that this would be discussed at the Village Hall Meeting on the 17th October 2022.</p>
71/22	<p>Reports: 71/22.01 H&DJBC – Members discussed the need for new appointments in due course following the sad loss of Michael Glendinning. 71/22.02 Village Hall Cllr M Wood reported, that groups were beginning to return to hire the hall. It was mentioned that Cllrs B Mason, H Maxted and E Switzer could assist with opening and closing the hall in the future if needed at Cllr Woods direction 71/22.03 Millennium Green Agreement given to remove Ash Tree at section 62/22.01. Cllr Maxted affixing new jubilee signage. 71/22.04 Play Area Play area has been inspected and weeds killed by Cllr B Mason. It was noted that we are still waiting to hear about the "Wetpour" required for underneath the swings from Cemetery staff. The clerk was getting in touch regarding this, however it may be that this matter need to be deferred until new appointments are made in the H&DJBC. 71/22.05 Footpaths Cllr E Switzer noted that following inspection earlier in the month the footpath at the Tipalt Burn Walk is now passable. 71/22.06 Greenhead School Cllr Sharp who had joined the meeting at this point reported that the school was performing well. The new head Mike Glenton has been well received and there are now 44 students. Also the trees overhanging the playground will be trimmed by G Reichart in due course at the expense of the School rather than the Landowner.</p>
