#### Guide Dogs urgently appeal for volunteer fosterers.

Have you ever thought you would love to have a dog but work full time? Would you like to make a real difference to the lives of people living with sight loss? Then this could be the perfect opportunity for you. Guide dogs are looking for volunteer fosterers.

As a Training Dog fosterer, your role is to take the dog to 'school' for training in the mornings and collect them before 5pm during the working week. At the weekends we spend time doing 'normal' dog activities like walks, free runs and lots of play! You are not expected to do much training with the dog, merely encourage and maintain behaviours they are working on in school, such as loose lead walking, crossing the road or walking up and down stairs.

Nadia a volunteer fosterer who works full time, said: "You get all the benefits of having a pet at home, without the financial commitments and other burdens that can come with having your own dog. Guide Dogs provide everything when the dog moves in - food, bedding, lead, and vets' bills are also covered, and they're always on hand to support you. If you want to go away on holiday the team will arrange for holiday cover too. Eventually the dog will leave to start their next chapter. This is the hardest part of being a Fosterer, but it helps to remember that you are directly involved in a vital part of the process to make a significant difference for someone with sight loss; and then you can get another dog to take care of!"
