

## **General Data Protection Regulations**

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) took effect in the UK in 2018. It replaced the existing law on data protection and gave individuals more rights and protection regarding how their personal data is used by councils. Parish Councils must comply with its requirements, just like any other organisation.
