The above Order, made on 15th October 2025, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Former Tynedale District

Restricted Byway No 65 / Footpath No 34 (Parish of Bardon Mill)

Upgrading thereto to restricted byway status (and renumbering as RB 65), part of existing Public Footpath No 34, from a point marked W, at the southern end of existing Byway Open to All Traffic No 45, 680 metres east of Allensgreen Farm, in a southerly direction for a distance of 580 metres to a point marked X, 450 metres east of Penpeugh.

Byways Open to All Traffic Nos 45 & 46 (Parish of Bardon Mill)

The Definitive Statements for these existing public right of way will be amended to reflect the addition of Restricted Byway No 65.

These details are shown on the Order map. A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at the Council Offices of Hexham Library, Queens Hall, Beaumont Street, Hexham, NE 46 3LS and the offices of Legal Services, County Hall, Morpeth during normal working hours. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.


Restricted Byway No 65 (Parish of Bardon Mill)

This Order is made by Northumberland County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Section 53(3)(c)(ii) and (iii), namely, that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description; and that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Northumberland County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 August 2025.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland shall be modified as described in the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Northumberland County Council Definitive Map Modification Order (No 6) 2025.

Description of Modification to Definitive Map and Statement

Former Tynedale District

Bardon Mill	Restricted Byway No 65	(NY 76 SE)
Part I	Map:	Upgrading thereto to restricted byway status, existing Public Footpath No 34, from a point marked W, at the southern end of existing Byway Open to All Traffic No 45, 680 metres east of Allensgreen Farm, in a southerly direction for a distance of 580 metres to a point marked X, on the U7066 road, 450 metres east of Penpeugh.
Part II	Statement:	To be prepared as follows: As an 14.63 metre wide restricted byway, from a junction with Byway Open to All Traffic No 45 and Public Footpath No 34, 680 metres east of Allensgreen Farm, in a southerly direction for a distance of 580 metres, to a junction with Byway Open to All Traffic No 46 and the U7066 road, 450 metres east of Penpeugh.

Bardon Mill **Footpath No 34** **(NY 76 SE)**

Part I Map: Deleting thereto the footpath, from a point marked W, at the southern end of Byway Open to All Traffic No 45, 680 metres east of Allensgreen Farm, in a southerly direction for a distance of 580 metres to a point marked X on the U7066 road, 450 metres east of Penpeugh, as a consequence of this section being upgraded to restricted byway status, and renumbered as Restricted Byway No 65.

Part II Statement: To be amended as follows:
From Footpath No 14 in the Parish of Plenmeller with Whitfield Parish, at a ford over Willimoteswike Burn, in a north-easterly and easterly direction by Allensgreen to join Restricted Byway No 65, at its junction with Byway Open to All Traffic No 45, 680 metres east of Allensgreen Farm.

Bardon Mill **Byway Open to All Traffic No 45** **(NY 76 SE)**

Part I Map: The Map is not affected.

Part II Statement: To be amended as follows:
As a 2.5 metre wide metalled (tarred) road for a distance of 1270 metres, from Restricted Byway No 65, 680 metres east of Allens Green Farm, in a general northerly direction, passing to the east of The Mill and Willimoteswick to a field gate 50 metres west of Willimoteswick Cottage, then as a 2.5 metre wide grass surfaced road for a distance 380 metres in a north-westerly direction to the south bank of the River South Tyne, then continuing in a general northerly direction along the river bank for 300 metres before turning in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 50 metres, to join Byway No 28 (U7064 road) at the Henshaw Parish boundary at the mid-point of the River South Tyne.

Bardon Mill **Byway Open to All Traffic No 46** **(NY 76 SE)**

Part I Map: The Map is not affected.

Part II Statement: To be amended as follows:
A 2.5 metre wide metalled (stone surfaced) road, 2040 metres in length, from the U7066 road and Restricted Byway No 65, 450 metres east of Penpeugh, in a general south-westerly direction to join Byway Open to All Traffic No 26 (U7066 road) in the Parish of Plenmeller with Whitfield, 400 metres north-east of Rock House.
