You can now use the “Fix My Street” option at Northumberland County Council to report, view, or discuss local problems (eg graffiti, fly tipping, broken paving slabs, or street lighting)

How to report a problem:

- Enter a Northumberland postcode, or street name and area
- Locate the problem on a map of the area
- Enter details of the problem
- Confirm the report and Northumberland County Council will investigate
